- online at vote.nd.gov (scroll down to "Vote by Mail/Absentee") to get started;
- ·by calling the Cass County Finance Office at 701.241.5600 to request an application be mailed to you; or
- ·in person by visiting the Cass County Finance Office (located in the Cass County Courthouse).

Absentee ballots for domestic voters who have applied will be available starting September 29, 2022.

Return your absentee ballot:

- •by mail (P.O. Box 2806, Fargo, ND 58108-2806);
- ·by secure drop box (located outside the Cass County Courthouse); or
- ·in person at the Cass County Finance Office (located in the Cass County Courthouse).

Absentee ballots must be placed into the envelope provided, signed, and returned to the Cass County Finance Office by 5:00 p.m. on November 7, 2022.
